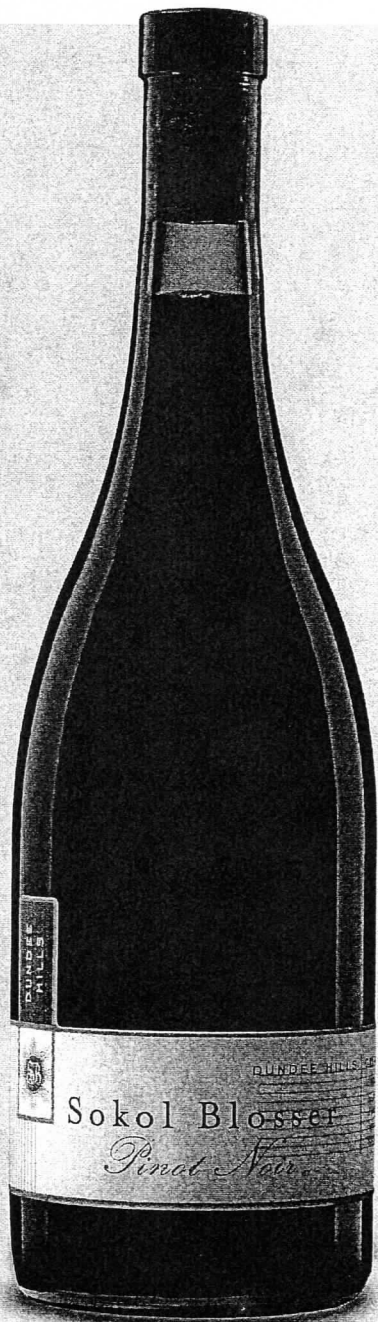


DUNDEE HILLS PINOT NOIR

The fruits of sustainable farming. Flavors of black cherry and raspberry mingling with earth and truffle. Aromas of the same. 16 months in French oak. Love & care.



THE WINE

This wine epitomizes everything Sokol Blosser has stood for since we planted our first vines in 1971. Our Dundee Hills Pinot Noir is born each year in the heart of Oregon's Pinot Noir country. A majority of the grapes are organically estate grown and are primarily from our new Dijon clones and our favorite clone, Pommard. Each bottle is tightly structured for long-term aging, yet the tannins are soft and smooth. In addition to the raspberry/cherry/earth/truffle notes, a dusty cola/mocha component is noticed because of the French oak. Properly cellared this wine should last 10-15 years.

PAIRINGS

Wild salmon, Ahi tuna, wild game, duck, pork, rack of lamb and filet mignon (or whatever cut you prefer) pairs beautifully with our Dundee Hills Pinot Noir. It will hold up to the most intense flavors, but not overwhelm.
